

In the Remarks Column, unless you type something in, it will show (no club info), unless you've set that up (see full file for info). You can enter whatever info you want in the remarks column. You may use as many or as few of these color sequences as you wish; to me, this "brightens up" the log. A station can have more than one status (i.e. Net Control and Logger). To clear the current status, just press the F9 key.

Pos. 1 – Dark Cyan – Operator (you). Status: op

Pos. 2 – Dark Purple – Net Control. Status: nc

Pos. 3 – Light Purple – Logger. Status: log

Pos. 4 – Orange – Relayed In By Another Station (i.e. via phone patch). Status: rel

Pos. 5 – Maroon – Net Control for another net, or for a position in a ham radio club/group. Status: vip

Pos. 6 – Red Orange – Mobile, Portable, QRP, Club Award, Special Event Station, etc. Status: W (F3)

Pos. 7 – Light Green – Station With Traffic for the net. Status: n (F4)

Pos. 8 – Gray – Courtesy Check, or Checked Out Of The Net Early. Status: c/o (F5)

Pos. 9 – Yellow – Not Heard. Status: n/h (F6)

Pos. 10 – Cyan – Short Time. Status: u (F7)

Pos. 11 – Dark Green – No Response. Status: n/r (F8)

Pos. 12 – White – Regular Checkin to the net, with or without general comments. No status or F-key used.
